KNUCKLE BOOM ESB

MALTY & SPICY WITH A HINT OF RYE, IT'S AN EASY DRINKING SESSION ALE. ESB IS AN ENGLISH STYLE ALE THAT FALLS IN THE "BITTER" CATEGORY. THERE ARE THREE SEPARATE RECOGNIZED STYLES WITHIN THE WORLD OF BITTERS: STANDARD OR ORDINARY BITTER, SPECIAL BITTER, AND EXTRA SPECIAL OR STRONG BITTER, BETTER KNOWN AS ESB. "KNUCKLE BOOM" IS A HYDRAULICALLY OPERATED TRUCK WHOSE MECHANICAL ACTION IMITATES AN ARM.

TRY WITH OUR PRIME BURGER

BEAVER BAIT BLONDE

AN EASY DRINKING ALE, PERFECT TO QUENCH YOUR THIRST & WAKE UP YOUR TASTE BUDS. THIS ALE IS PERFECT FOR PEOPLE WHO ENJOY LAGERS. IT IS LOW IN MALTY FLAVOR AND LOW IN HOPS/BITTERNESS. IN THE LOGGING WORLD, "BEAVER BAIT" MEANS LOOSE LOGS AND DEBRIS.

FRESH HOP IPA

CITRUS AND TROPICAL FRUIT AROMAS GREET YOU ON THE NOSE WITH THIS WET "FRESH" HOP INDIA PALE ALE. OVER 9LBS PER BARREL!!

TRY WITH OUR BEER BATTERED ONION RINGS

SIDEWINDER STOUT

DARK AND RICH WITH BOLD ROASTYNESS, NOTES OF ROASTED COFFEE AND A HINT OF DARK CHOCOLATE. THE AMERICAN STOUT IS INSPIRED FROM ENGLISH & IRISH STOUTS. THE MAIN DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE PORTER AND THE STOUT IS THAT THE STOUT IS MADE WITH ROASTED BARLEY WHERE THE PORTER IS NOT. STOUTS WERE TRADITIONALLY THE GENERIC TERM FOR THE STRONGEST OR STOUTEST PORTERS. "SIDEWINDER" IS A LIMB OR SAPLING THAT IS BENT UNDER A TREE THAT HAS BEEN FELLED.

TRY WITH OUR STOUT INFUSED DEVIL EGG

KNOTTED PORTER

THIS ROBUST PORTER IS DARK & ROASTY. CHOCOLATE MALT, MILD BITTERNESS AND LOW HOP AROMA, ALLOWS THIS MALTY ELIXIR TO SHINE. PORTERS ORIGINATED OUT OF LONDON AND WERE NAMED AFTER THE TRANSPORT WORKERS OF THE DAY THAT CONSUMED A LOT OF DARK ALES.

OLD GROWTH BARLEYWINE

10 OZ TULIP

THE 2017 VERSION OF OUR OLD GROWTH HAS A LONG AND LUSCIOUS BITTER TOFFEE FINISH. AS AN AMERICAN STYLE BARLEYWINE IT CELEBRATES THE HOP AND MALT MARRIAGE. AGED 110 DAYS IN STAINLESS PRIOR TO RELEASE

SASQUATCH CDA

(CASCADIAN DARK ALE)

HOPPY AS AN IPA, YET BLACK & RICH FROM ROASTED WHEAT MALT. SASQUATCH IS A RARE, BUT REFINED BEAST. CDA, ALSO KNOWN AS A BLACK IPA OR INDIA BLACK ALE. IT'S AN IPA FOR DARK BEER FANS. "SASQUATCH" DO YOU BELIEVE?

IBU: 66, ABV: 6.0%

TRY WITH OUR SASQUATCH FRIES

GREENLEAF IPA

HOPS, HOPS, HOPS. USING A TECHNIQUE CALLED HOP BURSTING, THIS IPA DELIVERS A MELLOW BITTERNESS WITH STRONG HOP AROMA & FLAVOR. THE STYLE IPA WAS THE ORIGINAL 'PALE' ALE OF ENGLAND, CREATED WITH MORE HOPS TO STABILIZE THE BEER WHILE BEING EXPORTED TO INDIA (HENCE THE NAME) AND LATER ADOPTED FOR DOMESTIC CONSUMPTION. BASED ON BOTHELL HISTORY, COLUMBUS S. GREENLEAF WAS ONE OF THE FIRST SETTLERS IN BOTHELL.

IBU: 60, ABV: 6.4%

TRY WITH OUR HOUSE MADE HUMMUS

FOUR GINGER IPA

FEATURING FRESH GINGER, THAI GINGER, PICKLED & CANDIED GINGER, THIS IPA DANCES ON YOUR TASTE BUDS, TRULY A PALATE PLEASER.

IBU 60; 6.4% ABV

TRY WITH OUR KALBI MEAT CANDY

PATCH CUT PUMPKIN ALE

A ROBUST SLICE OF PUMPKIN PIE IN A GLASS FEATURING CLASSIC PIE SPICES, & A LOT OF PUMPKIN. PUMPKIN ALE DATES BACK TO THE EARLY 18TH CENTURY WHEN IT WAS USED TO AUGMENT GRAIN FOR ITS FREMENTABLE SUGARS. TODAY SPICES ARE ADDED TO MAKE PUMPKIN ALES TASTE LIKE PUMPKIN PIE. "PATCH CUTS" ARE LOGGING CUTS TOO SMALL TO BE CONSIDERED CLEAR CUTS.

JERRY IPA

JERRY IPA IS A HOPPY, JUICY, OVER THE TOP INDIA PALE ALE THAT IS RIPE WITH FLAVOR AND AROMA. FEATURING COLUMBUS, CITRA, SIMCOE AND LOTS OF AMARILLO HOPS USED FOR DRY HOPPING. A SLIGHTLY SWEET MALT PRESENCE SUPPORTS THIS MULE OF A HOPPY ALE. SPEAKING OF MULES, JERRY IS NAMED AFTER A 922LB ARKANSAS LOGGING MULE FROM THE SONG TIMBER (HO).

IBU 80; 7.4% ABV

TRY WITH ANY OF OUR SAUSAGES

HARVEST AMBER ALE

AN EASY DRINKING AMBER ALE THAT IS FULL OF FRUITY FLAVOR FROM THE USE OF NEW ZEALAND WAIMEA AND PACIFICA HOPS, AND A WHITBREAD ENGLISH ALE YEAST STRAIN THAT ACCENTUATES FRUIT FORWARD FLAVORS.
