### BEAVER BAIT BLONDE

An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, "Beaver bait" means loose logs and debris.

IBU: 35; ABV: 5.1%

### MOSAIC PALE ALE

Mosaic hops are featured in this North West style pale. This aromatic ale smells like mango juice mixed with papaya and apricot. Those flavors carry through on the palate with the added notes of orange and white grapefruit. The name was chosen to highlight this delicious hop.

IBU: 37; ABV: 5.9%

### PONDEROSA PILSNER

Pilsners were first brewed in the Czechoslovakian city of Pilsen in 1840. Ours uses Budvar yeast and Czech Saaz hops to lend authenticity to this classic beer style. "Lagered" cold for 35 days.

IBU: 35; ABV: 5.3%

### SEQUOIA IRA

Our IRA ~ some call it Imperial some call it India Red Ale, is hoppy like an IPA yet malty like an Amber Ale. Hopped with Simcoe and Centennial hops.

IBU: 52; ABV: 6.3%

### MAKE ME HOPPY IPA

A double India Pale Ale featuring Galaxy and Mosaic Hops. This is the first beer from Beardslee using Cryo Hops (or hop kief - only the resinous glands of the hop cones). Brewed with Scott Urban, who purchased the prize "Be Your Own Brewer" at the 2017 NW Children's Fund auction.

IBU: 65 ABV: 7.5%

### DORTMUNDER LAGER

A German style export lager. This style originated in the city of Dortmund and was popular with coal miners in the area. For our take on this style we used all Washington malt from Skagit Malting Co in Mt Vernon, and paired it with German Topaz and Hallertau Tradition hops.

IBU: 30 ABV: 5.25%

### GREENLEAF IPA

Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor. The style IPA was the original 'pale' ale of England, created with more hops to stabilize the beer while being exported to India (hence the name) and later adopted for domestic consumption. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first settlers in Bothell.

IBU: 60; ABV: 6.4%

### FOUR GINGER IPA

Featuring fresh ginger, thai ginger, pickled & candied ginger, this IPA dances on your taste buds, truly a palate pleaser.

IBU: 60; ABV: 6.4%

### KNUCKLE BOOM ESB

Malty & spicy with a hint of rye, it is an easy drinking session ale. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the "bitter" category. There are three separate recognized styles within the world of bitters: standard or ordinary bitter, special bitter, and extra special or strong bitter, better known as ESB. "Knuckle Boom" is a hydraulically operated truck whose mechanical action imitates an arm.

IBU: 40; ABV: 5.5%

### WIDOW MAKER WIT -13oz Tulip

A Light, crisp & refreshing Belgian style wit Flavored with orange peel & coriander. This wheat ale is a 400 year old beer style that died out in the 1950's; it was later revived by Pierre Celis at Hoegaarden, and has grown steadily in popularity over time. Wit means "white", describing the beer's pale color and cloudy appearance. "Widow Maker" is a logging term meaning a loose limb that may fall on a logger and make that logger's spouse a widow.

IBU: 24; ABV: 6.1%.

### SHAY NITRO STOUT

This light bodied ale has a silky mouth feel from being dispensed with nitrogen gas. Accompanied by flavors of roasted malt and chocolate. Irish stouts, also known as dry stouts are known for their drinkability. The style was made famous by the Guinness brewery in Ireland. "Shay" is a steam locomotive adapted to logging and noted for its agility and indestructibility.

IBU: 40; ABV: 5.0%
