Greenleaf IPA

Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor. The style IPA was the original 'pale' ale of England, created with more hops to stabilize the beer while being exported to India (hence the name) and later adopted for domestic consumption. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first settlers in Bothell.

IBU 60; 6.4% ABV

Beaver Bait Blonde

An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, "Beaver bait" means loose logs and debris.

IBU 35; 5.1% ABV

Rooster Rye Pale Ale

Featuring the 7 hop blend of Falconer Flight hops on the finish, and with Nugget hops providing the bitterness. This pale ale is a hop forward beer with spicy rye malt shining through adding a complexity to this classic NW Style pale ale.

IBU 45; 5.8% ABV

Dark Days Nitro Coffee Stout

Big and rich and thick and smooth, this nitrogen dispensed [think Guinness] stout has been aged on ½ lb per barrel of Sumatra coffee beans. Released on the Winter Solstice- the Darkest Day of the year.

IBU: 40; 8.4% ABV

Campfire Rauchbier

A lightly smoked amber ale with a sweet and lingering smoky finish. We used 10% cherry smoked malt, and 7% house smoked apple wood munich malt to enhance the aromatics and flavor of this ale

Four Ginger IPA

Featuring fresh, Thai, pickled & candied ginger, this IPA dances on your taste buds, truly a palate pleaser.

Grapple Belgian Tripel

13 OZ TULIP

An American version of a classic Belgian ale made famous by the monks in Belgium. On the palate notes of flint and orange marmalade mingle with the sweet ethanol and a luscious mouth feel.

Bothell Belgian Brut

Brewed in collaboration with Eric Jorgensen Head Brewer at North Fork Brewery, Pizzeria and Beer Shrine in Deming WA. Our Brut is extremely light bodied and crisp; a Belgian style pale ale that has been fermented to an extremely dry, or Brut condition with the addition of Amylo enzymes. Very little residual sugar remains as most of it has been converted to ethanol. This is Beardslee's

Stadium IPA

A boldly hop forward India Pale Ale that showcases Centennial and Citra hop aromas and a smooth lingering bitterness. **Featured in the Beardslee Public House stands at Century Link Field.**

IBU 55; 6.8% ABV

Knuckle Boom ESB

Malty & spicy with a hint of rye, it is an easy drinking ale. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the "bitter" category. There are three separate recognized styles within the world of bitters: standard or ordinary, special, and extra special or strong bitter, better known as ESB. "Knuckle Boom" is a hydraulically operated truck with a mechanical arm.

Whiny The Complainer

10 OZ SNIFTER ONLY

A collaboration brew with Washington's oldest brewpub, The Big Time Brewery in the U-District.

Whiny was first brewed by our head brewer Drew when he worked at the Big Time back in 2012. Whiny is a triple IPA – Big and Bold, and highly alcoholic! It is named Whiny to “honor” the fans of Russian River's Pliny the Younger – who complained when Russian River pulled out of Washington State in 2012.
