## **Beaver Bait Blonde**

An easy-drinking ale, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. This ale is perfect for people who enjoy lagers. It is low in malty flavor and low in hops/bitterness. In the logging world, "Beaver bait" means loose logs.

## **Ponderosa Pilsner**

An easy drinking lager, perfect to quench your thirst & wake up your taste buds. Featuring Kazbek and Hallertau Tradition hops.

## **Lemon Saison**

*13 OZ TULIP*

Using a Norwegian Farmhouse yeast strain, Voss Kveik; and several pounds of dehydrated lemon peel, this summer sipper is extremely approachable and easy drinking.

## **Orange Creamsicle Ale**

**[ CONTAINS LACTOSE ]**

Flavored with orange peel and vanilla beans; and featuring the fruit forward hops; Jarrylo, Idaho Gem and Mandarin Bavarian, this ale is reminiscent of a creamsicle ice cream bar. The addition of lactose (milk sugar) enhances the creamy texture of this easy sipper.

## **Widow Maker Wit**

*13 OZ TULIP*

A Light, crisp & refreshing Belgian style wheat ale brewed with orange peel and coriander. Wit means "white" describing the beer's pale color and cloudy appearance. Widow Maker is a logging term meaning a loose limb that may fall on a logger and make that logger's spouse a widow.

## **Inviculus IPA**

A collaboration brew done with our friend Bradley from Invictus brewery in Blaine Minnesota. It is brewed in the hazy style and is a play on a beer, "Icculus", which we both formerly made at the Big Time Brewery. Featuring tropical fruit forward Nelson Sauvin hops from New Zealand, and NW

Mosaic hops.

### **Stadium IPA**

A boldly hop forward India Pale Ale that showcases Centennial and Citra hop aromas and a smooth lingering bitterness. **Featured in the Beardslee Public House stands at Century Link Field.**

IBU 55; 6.8% ABV

### **Greenleaf IPA**

Hops, Hops, Hops. Made using a technique called hop bursting, this IPA delivers a mellow bitterness with strong hop aroma & flavor. The style IPA was the original 'pale' ale of England, created with more hops to stabilize the beer while being exported to India (hence the name) and later adopted for domestic consumption. Named for Bothell history, Columbus S. Greenleaf was one of the first settlers in Bothell.

IBU 60; 6.4% ABV

### **Knuckle Boom ESB**

Malty & spicy with a hint of rye, it is an easy drinking ale. ESB is an English style ale that falls in the "bitter" category. There are three separate recognized styles within the world of bitters: standard or ordinary, special, and extra special or strong bitter, better known as ESB. "Knuckle Boom" is a hydraulically operated mechanical arm.

IBU 40; 5.50% ABV

### **Cherry Sour Ale**

*13 OZ TULIP*

A kettle sour mash makes this light and refreshing ale that is aged with Montmorency tart cherries from Michigan. Both thirst quenching and delightfully refreshing.

### **Bourbon Barrel Aged**

#### **Sidewinder Stout** *10 OZ GOBLET*

Dark and rich with bold roastyness, notes of roasted coffee and a hint of dark chocolate. Aged 4 months in a Buffalo Trace Bourbon Barrel. Released on 8/9 to mark our 4<sup>th</sup> Anniversary as Bothell's favorite Public House.
